

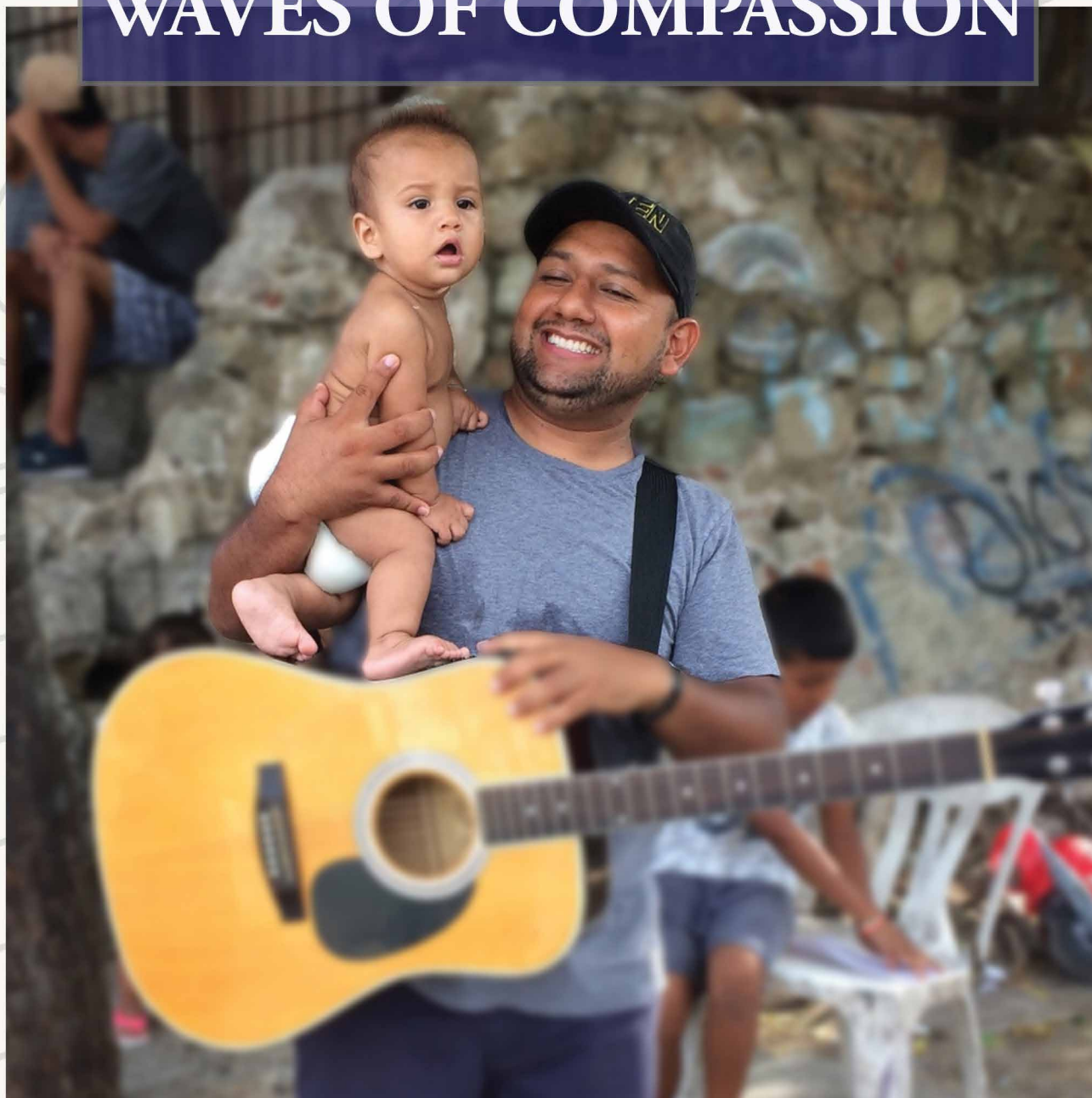

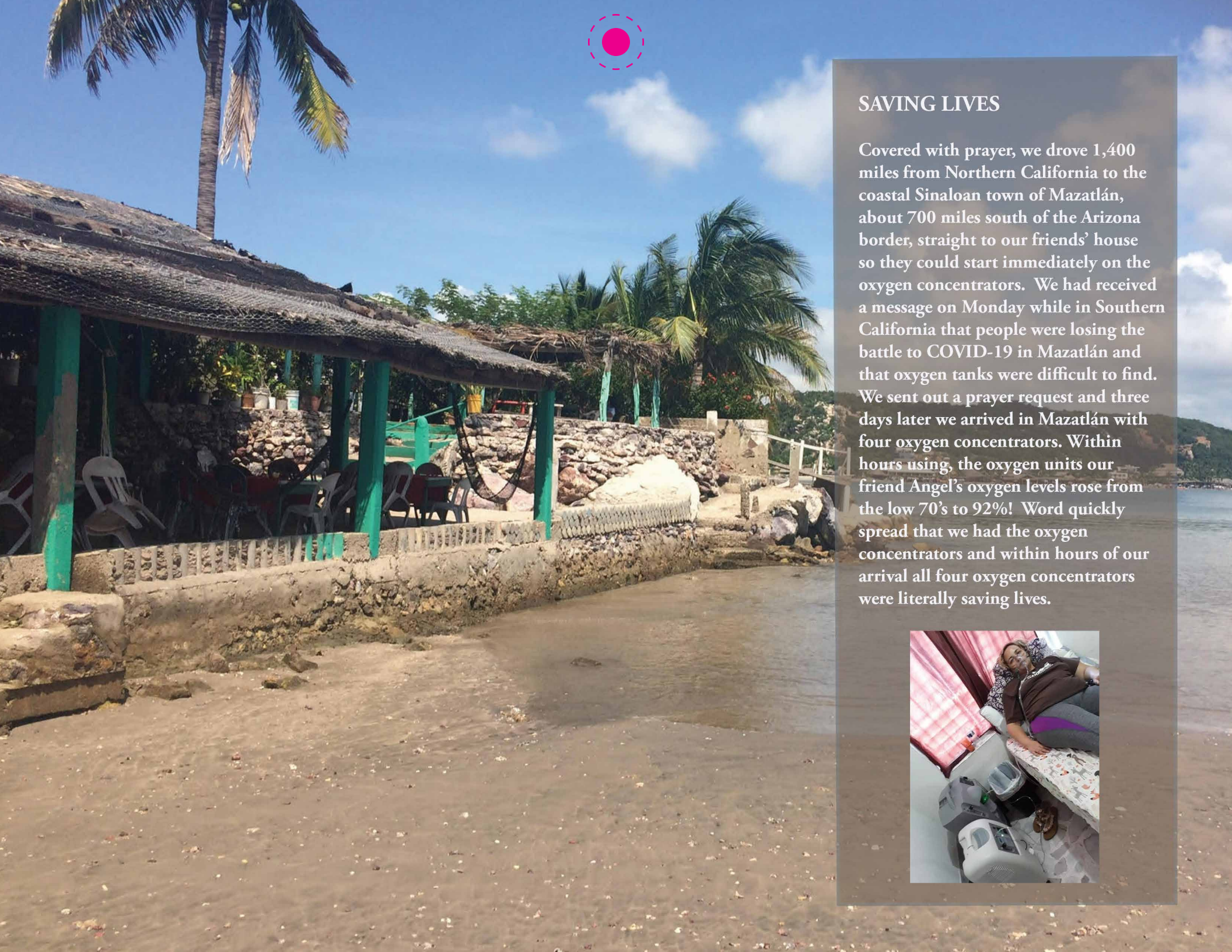

SAVING LIVES

Covered with prayer, we drove 1,400 miles from Northern California to the coastal Sinaloan town of Mazatlán, about 700 miles south of the Arizona border, straight to our friends’ house so they could start immediately on the oxygen concentrators. We had received a message on Monday while in Southern California that people were losing the battle to COVID-19 in Mazatlán and that oxygen tanks were difficult to find. We sent out a prayer request and three days later we arrived in Mazatlán with four oxygen concentrators. Within hours using, the oxygen units our friend Angel’s oxygen levels rose from the low 70’s to 92%! Word quickly spread that we had the oxygen concentrators and within hours of our arrival all four oxygen concentrators were literally saving lives.

IMAGINE A HEALTH CLINIC
WITHOUT MEDICINE

Before Maria’s kidneys began to fail, she worked in the fields picking tomatoes. Once the catheter was installed in her abdomen to facilitate dialysis, which she needs three times a week, she had to stop working for fear of infection. Because of the lack of supplies at the government’s healthcare clinics, patient’s families must purchase medicines and medical supplies from an offsite pharmacy for their loved ones to receive treatment.

Maria’s family only had enough money to purchase the IV tubing and other supplies for two days that week. Thankfully because of our wonderful partners, who pray and financially support the ministry, Amazing Grace Maritime Missions, provided the supplies enabling them to give Maria and others like her life saving medical care.

EQUIPPING FIRST RESPONDERS

Upon arrival, we discovered that the Cruz Roja (Red Cross) of San Ignacio, serving a municipality of 7000 people, had one blood pressure monitor and a few first aid supplies shared between their two ambulances. Amazing Grace Maritime Missions gave these first responders enough supplies to care for approximately 300 people and with your help we can provide medical supplies to the other 180+ Cruz Rojas which serve the communities around the Sea of Cortez. Each kit includes essential exam materials, wound care and personal hygiene items — supplies that are critical to have, yet desperately lacking in most clinics in the communities Amazing Grace Maritime Missions serves.

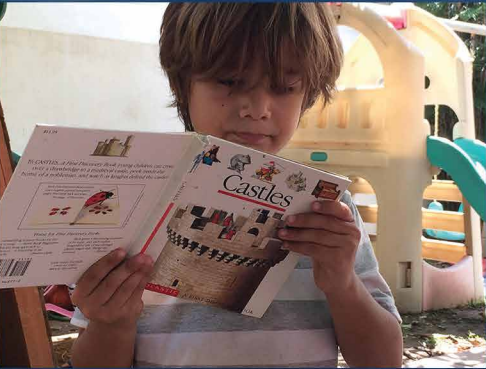

THE GIFT OF GLASSES

Participating with Youth With A Mission Mazatlán’s medical clinic in an outlying village, Chatelier found a box of donated reading glasses in the medical supplies. She gave them and a bible to another volunteer who had no training in ophthalmology but was eager to help. She organized the reading glasses by the numbers on them. “2.0”, “1.5” and so on. With bible in hand and a willing heart we witnessed a miracle. One by one a person would sit down next to the volunteer. She fitted glasses on them and instructed the local villager to “read the words until they became clear.” After being able to see clearly, she and another Spanish speaking volunteer asked them if they understood what they were reading. With tears in their eyes God’s words became clear and they responded with joy. Twelve people left with a pair of glasses, a bible and Jesus Christ’s love in their hearts.

DENTAL CLINIC

On a sunny Saturday morning, joined by dental professionals from Mexico and the United States, Amazing Grace Maritime Missions sponsored a dental clinic in a rural community outside of Mazatlán. Dr. Mariana, a native of Mazatlán, prepared the lesson called, “Lo que hace felices a los dientes.” Or in English, “What Makes Teeth Happy.”

In this clinic, the kids learned how to care for their teeth through proper brushing. After the health lesson, they reinforced healthy eating habits through fun crafts such as cutting paper shapes of fruits and vegetables and placing them on a cut-out tooth with a smile while placing candy and soda paper cut-outs on a tooth with a frown. After providing a nutritious lunch, the team distributed toothbrushes and toothpaste to the children to practice what they learned followed by dental exams and fluoride applications.

MEXICO’S FIRST MEDICAL SHIP

Access to healthcare in remote coastal villages of the Sea of Cortez, Mexico is a challenge. The nearest hospital or dental clinics can be several hours away traveling on dirt roads. Partnering with Youth With A Mission (YWAM) Ships Mazatlán, who invested time and money restoring the m/v Amazing Grace, we can deliver basic healthcare to these villages and provide housing and meals for the volunteer medical professionals, YWAM students and certified ship’s crew. According to Sinaloa’s Department of Health, m/v Amazing Grace is the first medical ship to serve the people of the Sea of Cortez, Mexico.
