Dear Friends,

Grace and peace to you in the name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. I pray that as you journey through this year you will experience the continued blessings of God's amazing grace.

When I was introduced to the Greater Washington District as your superintendent, I became aware of the work of the Rev. Adrienne Terry, who was pastor at Christ UMC in Southwest Washington, D.C., at the time of her death. As I reviewed Rev. Terry's life, my attention was brought to her strong advocacy for the least among us, in particular, the need for affordable housing. In her memory and to address the critical need for affordable housing, I asked our district Lay Leader, Mary McCurty, to engage in a special project -- to identify 52 Scripture passages that speak to homelessness. She and church lay leaders created 52 prayers, inspired by these Scriptures, which speaks to homelessness. This calendar is the result of their collective efforts.

The calendar creates an opportunity for the Greater Washington District to scripturally and prayerfully focus on homelessness. After our lay leaders created the calendar, they issued an additional challenge that I'm excited to present to you. We are asking each congregation to receive two calendars, and put them to use -- committing to read the Scriptures and pray the prayers weekly.

Then, commit to make a financial contribution, consistent with the weekly calendar, to address homelessness. For example, for week one, read the Scripture, pray the prayer, and contribute \$1 toward homelessness. For week two, read the Scripture, pray, and contribute \$2 toward homelessness. For week 52, read the Scripture, pray, and contribute \$52 toward homelessness.

Our goal is for each congregation to commit (either as individuals or groups) to this focus on homelessness each week for a year. The funds collected will be used to support affordable housing opportunities on our district.

We can do this together. If each of our 70 congregations commits to making all 52 daily donations we will collectively raise in excess of \$90,000 for homelessness.

We are family and our willingness to come together to support our neighbors is part of the legacy that we can pass on as the Greater Washington District. In so doing we also honor the memory and continue the work of Rev. Adrienne Terry and all the people serving in our pulpits and pews to make sure every person in our midst has a home.

Rev. Adrienne Terry, 65, an active Elder serving Christ UMC in Southwest Washington, D.C., died suddenly June 24, 2016. Her Celebration of Life service was July 9 at Asbury UMC in Washington.



Adrienne Terry was born Nov. 6, 1950, in Detroit Mich., the eldest of two children of Willie L. and Nettie M. Terry. She attended the Detroit public schools. She played the piano, violin, flute and sang in the church and school choirs. She participated in Wayne State University's Upward Bound Program and, at 16, received a full scholarship from Martin Luther King Foundation to attend Western Michigan University in Kalamazoo. She was the first person in her family to receive a college degree, a Bachelors of Arts in Special Education.

Terry taught special education in the Royal Oak, Mich. school system where she met and married Edsel Goode. They had one child. After moving to Washington, D.C., with her daughter in 1979, she applied her passion about issues pertaining to women, children, poverty, and HIV/AIDS by working as a leader and supervisor in Washington, and Maryland educational advocacy programs.

At the age of 29, she became a principal of Edgemoade School for troubled youth in Upper Marlboro and later served as a program director at For Love of Children (FLOC) and City Lights. During this time, Terry received her Master's in Special Education from George Washington University then worked in the Department of Health and Human Services, Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration.
