GREEN BAY
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The temperature is hovering around 20 below as the *S.S. City of Midland 41* enters Kewaunee Harbor to interchange with the GBW on February 16, 1988. This grand boat, considered by many to be the finest Great Lakes carferry ever, was built for the Pere Marquette Railway by Manitowoc Shipbuilding in 1941. It was part of the Chesapeake & Ohio’s fleet when Michigan-Wisconsin Transportation took over car-ferry operations in 1983. Under a fine plume of steam, the Kewaunee, Green Bay & Western’s only Mikado, the 403, storms west past the signals protecting the Milwaukee Road crossing at Hudson Street in Green Bay on April 17, 1947. The 403 was one of six 2-8-2s acquired by the GBW and KGB&W in 1937 and 1939. The only truly modern steam power the GBW owned, the 400s were well liked by crews for their speed, power and automatic stokers. GREEN BAY
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Train 2 is reflected in the Trempealeau River west of Whitehall on May 4, 1980, heading east behind C424s 312, 322 and 320. The Trempealeau carved out a gentle route through the coulee country on the GBW’s west end, but it would regularly overflow its banks and wash away ballast, roadbed, track and bridges. This part of the GBW has been rejuvenated by Canadian National with 136-pound welded rail and new ballast, ties and bridges to handle the CN’s booming frac sand business. Green Bay, Winona & St. Paul 4-4-0 18 plunged into the Embarrass River at New London when the bridge collapsed on September 14, 1889. GBW&StP’s “heavy duty” boom car no. 1 is standing on the bridge ready to go into action. Wisconsin Highway 35 is in the middle of a major reconstruction that obliterated many traces of the Chicago & North Western’s line to Winona, which crossed the GBW here. This train crossed the Mississippi River and interchanged with the Milwaukee Road in Winona the morning this photo was taken. 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Erie Western C420 207 switches Norwood Yard in October 1979. When this former Long Island passenger locomotive needed some heavy mechanical work, the Erie Western sent it to the GBW’s capable Norwood Shops. But the financially troubled ERES was unable to pay the bill, so the GBW used the 207 to work off the debt. The “Blue Goose,” as GBW employees called it, was put to work in the yards at Green Bay and Wisconsin Rapids. GBW 52 was one of six Thrall-Door boxcars the GBW acquired in 1971 and 1973. Their unique design featured moveable doors that made the entire side of the car accessible (although not all at once). They were used mostly for plywood sheathing loads or lumber that could not be exposed to the weather. They were usually assigned to lumber plants on the BN in Montana, Idaho and Washington state, and did not spend much time on home rails.
